AKA Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages

The Knowledge Workshop TEFL / TESOL course is a time and cost-effective introduction to the world of TEFL, one in which you can test your affinity for the profession and earn while you learn and grow as a teacher. Whether you are 18 or going on 60, have your roots firmly planted, or long for overseas adventures, TEFL is a passport to opportunities both locally and abroad.

What is TEFL/TESOL?

“TEFL” or Teaching English as a Foreign Language is a term used to describe the dynamic industry catering to students studying English in non-English speaking countries, as well as short-term educational tourists who travel to countries where the language is spoken. “TESOL” or Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages refers to the same industry.

Why TEFL?

The global spread of the English language, fuelled largely by growth in industry and commerce, has resulted in an ever-increasing need for qualified, native English-speaking teachers in non-English-speaking countries. This need has generated lucrative opportunities for anyone with a sense of adventure and love for the English language to travel, earn and teach.

Who is eligible?

Anyone older than 18, with mother-tongue proficiency in English and a minimum qualification of a matric certificate or equivalent is eligible. A brief, informative interview is a requirement.

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Knowledge Workshop TEFL/ TESOL course is an intensive 120-hour course, incorporating **70** hours of theory and **50** hours of practical training. In the theory component, participants actively engage with course content through a series of workshops, and gain valuable insight into the major teaching methodologies informing the industry.

Modules Covered:

- Introduction to the TEFL industry
Job opportunities – where and how to find work
- Textbook analysis – core, grammar and supplementary
- Mother tongue vs. foreign language acquisition and learning
- Major methodologies and their application
- Stepping out of the text book:
 - Grammar – a broad introduction
 - Grammar – top-down teaching to contextual learning
 - Grammar – the presentation of grammar items in context
- The choice and use of authentic texts in the EFL / ESL classroom
- The Four Skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking)
- Facilitating conversation classes
- Classroom management techniques
- Activities for the EFL classroom
- Lesson planning and curriculum design
- Teaching English to Young Learners

THEORY COMPONENT

Week 1: Monday – Friday, 5pm to 10pm; Week 2: Monday – Friday, 5pm to 10pm, plus Saturday daytime, 9:30am to ~4:30pm.

The theory component culminates on the Saturday when participants present practical lessons as part of their final assessment.

Due to the practical, workshop-nature of the course, high levels of motivation and enthusiasm are essential for participants to experience the full benefit of the course. Participants will be required to prepare homework tasks for presentation in various micro-teaching encounters throughout the course.

PRACTICAL COMPONENT

Practical training takes place over 5 days and provides participants with invaluable experience working with both EFL (English Foreign Language) and ESL (English Second Language) students. Training is a guided, mentored process involving observation, teaching, lesson planning, checking and evaluating homework, classroom management and resource development. Times to be arranged with the facilitator.

Course outcomes

Upon successful completion, participants receive a certificate highlighting the modules covered, and a letter of recommendation.

Course cost

The total cost of the course is **R9000**. A non-refundable deposit of R4000 is payable before the start of the course. The balance of payment (R5000) must be received on or before the first day of the course.
